



ROBERT MOREMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

Deadline April 3rd of the Graduating Year

The Robert Moreman Memorial Scholarship (RMMS) is available to graduating seniors from Wimberley High School (WHS) and Katherine Anne Porter School (KAPS) in Wimberley, Texas. The goal is to fund multiple \$5000+ scholarships annually, depending on available funds.

Students applying for this scholarship need to show how their continuing education will support one or more of Wimberley Valley Arts and Cultural Alliance (WimberleyArts.org)'s artistic pillars: visual, performing, literary and culinary arts, or how they are dedicated to becoming tradesmen: crafters, builders or makers.

Scholarships will be awarded to students seeking higher education in colleges, universities or after high school technical or trade schools. While academic performance (grades) will be considered during the selection process, they will not be the sole criterion when selecting the scholarship recipients. See requirements below.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Documents Required: The following should be submitted with the completed application:

Must be submitted between January 1st and no later than April 3rd of graduating year.

Documents Required: The following should be submitted with the completed application. • School-produced report showing GPA and grades. • Three signed letter(s) of recommendation from teachers, counselors, instructors, coaches, mentors • A one-page letter describing applicant's plans for college or trade/technical school and why they should be considered for this award. The letter should give the committee a sense of the passion and level of expertise the student has in their art form or trade and include outside interests or community involvement, as well as details regarding financial need. • **If Applicable:** One or two PDFs, JPEGs or video links that show samples of the applicant's creative work.

Applications can be completed on the website with the supporting documents uploaded. OR printed applications and documents can be mailed to Wimberley Valley Arts and Cultural Alliance, P. O. Box 608, Wimberley TX 78676. Please send questions to wimberleyarts@gmail.com.

FINALIST INTERVIEWS All applications will be reviewed by members of the WimberleyArts.org Scholarship Committee, who will create shortlist applicants to be invited to a personal interview. Once the interview process is complete, winners will be selected and both winning and not-winning applicants will be notified in writing.

Wimberley ISD and KAPS both have scholarship nights, attended by all graduating seniors. WimberleyArts.org will have representatives at these events and will present Certificates of Award to the winning students on the award night. Scholarship checks will be mailed to students once WimberleyArts.org receives the recipients' College/Trade/Technical school's confirmation of enrollment, acceptance and financial obligation.
